Code of Conduct for Juniors/Young Golfers

As a junior golfer taking part in a Llantrisant & Pontyclun Golf Club activity, you should:

- Help create and maintain an environment free of fear, discrimination and harassment.
- Demonstrate fair play, self-control and good standards both on and off the course.
- Obey the Rules of Golf with honesty and respect for the golf course and other players.
- Follow the instructions and restrictions requested by the coaches and adults looking after you, treat them with courtesy and value their advice.
- Respect other people and their differences, treating them how you would wish to be treated.
- Be organised and on time.
- Tell someone in authority if you are leaving the venue or competition.
- Accept that these guidelines are in place for the well-being and safety of all concerned.
- Look out for yourself and for the welfare of others.
- Speak to your parents or a club representative if you consider that you or others have been wrongly treated.
- Let the Club Welfare Officer know if you need any additional support or protection.

You should not take part in any irresponsible, abusive, inappropriate or illegal behaviour which includes:

- Smoking or vaping
- Using foul language
- Using critical or disrespectful descriptions of others either in person or through text, email or social network sites
- Consuming alcohol, illegal drugs or stimulants
